## THE CORNER CAMARO

This months' CORNER CAMARO is Ralph Merian's brand new 2023 Camaro SS convertible!

The journey to purchase my 2023 Camaro 2SS Convertible began right around the end of February. This is when I started considering exactly what I wanted in what will likely be the last Camaro I own. Besides my current 1993 Z28, I previously had owned a '67 SS/RS, a '69 Z28, and a '83 Z28. I've enjoyed Camaros since Chevy started making them and wanted to place the order in time to enjoy my new Camaro at all the Club's summer activities. So, after

deciding on the style, color, and options, I went to a locally owned dealership and placed my order for a "Vivid Orange Metallic" Camaro with all the specific options I desired.

Six weeks went by and no word from the dealership as to a production date for my car. I called them only to be told that they could not place the order, since they had not received the allocations needed from Chevy for my options. They would continue trying and hopefully the necessary allocations would eventually be given. Throughout May I called dealerships in the Metro area and asking if they had any orange Camaros in their inventory with my desired options. This was proving to be very unsuccessful, so I then went online at Chevrolet.com. I built the Camaro with all my options, and then searched dealerships within a 1000-mile radius with that inventory. The higher the number given meant it had my specific options. Eventually one was located about 235 miles away at Greenwood-Hubbard Chevrolet in Hubbard, OH, which had the closest possible match. Excited to find one almost exactly as I wanted, I called them only to be told that it was already in process of being sold. I gave them my number in case the deal fell through and continued my search.

Giving my number to the dealer in Hubbard turned out to be a blessing. They called just after the Memorial Day weekend and said the Camaro was mine if I still wanted it. On June 6th, I enjoyed driving my new 2023 "Vivid Orange Metallic" Camaro 2SS Convertible back home from the Greenwood-Hubbard Chevy dealer, and haven't stopped enjoying it.

**SATURDAY (JULY 8):** 9am - 4pm. Camaro Superfest Car Show. Drive or trailer your Camaro into the Park, shine it up and show it off. If your car is being judged, the judges will come to your car. Please be sure to enjoy all of the other Camaros that will be there. Talk to their owners. Everyone has a story to tell! Lots of other things to do too - food and ice cream trucks, axe throwing, Kids area, 50/50, and vendors!!

**SATURDAY EVENING (JULY 8):**  
5pm - 7pm. Dinner at the Park Starting around 5pm, Multi Lakes is serving a "casual dinner" on the order of burgers, brats fries, soft drink, etc. The cost is \$15 per person and you must pre-register for this event. 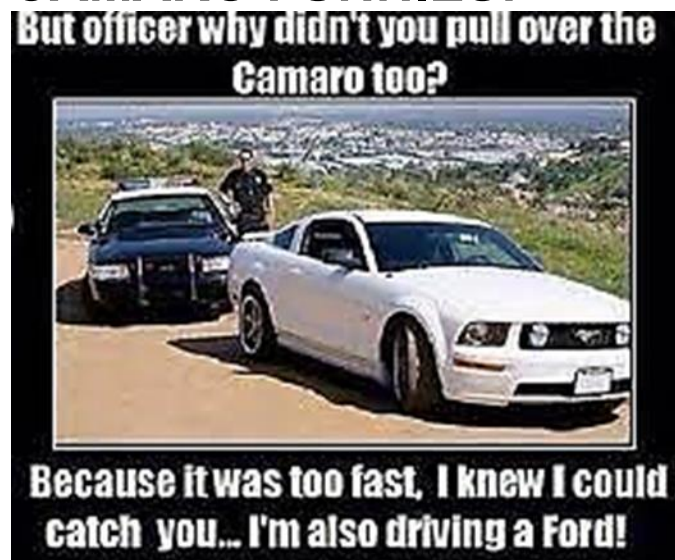

# Go hands-free. Just drive. It's the law.

It is now illegal to manually use a cell phone or other mobile electronic device while operating a vehicle on Michigan roads. Under the law, a driver cannot hold or support a phone or other device with any part of their hands, arms, or shoulders.

Even if a cell phone or other device is mounted on your dashboard or connected to your vehicle's built-in system, you cannot use your hands to operate it beyond a single touch.


As a result, you cannot manually do any of the following on a cell phone or other electronic device while driving:

-  Make or answer a telephone or video call.
-  Send or read a text or email message.
-  Watch, record, or send a video.
-  Access, read, or post to social media.
-  Browse or use the Internet.
-  Enter information into GPS or a navigation system.

The law makes holding or manually using a cell phone or other mobile electronic device while operating a vehicle a primary offense—which means an officer can stop and ticket drivers for this violation.

## PENALTIES

<b>1st violation</b> \$100 fine and/or 16 hours of community service.	<b>2nd or subsequent violations</b> \$250 fine and/or 24 hours of community service.	<b>3 violations within a 3-year period</b> Complete a driving-improvement course.
<b>Fines doubled</b>		
If a traffic crash occurs and the at-fault driver was holding or manually using a mobile device while operating the vehicle, any civil fines will be doubled.

**Q** Can I use my device while I am stopped at a light or in traffic?

You cannot hold or manually use a cell phone or other mobile electronic device at any time while operating a vehicle. Operation includes being stopped at a light or in traffic but does not include being legally parked.

**Q** My phone is mounted on my dashboard, so I'm hands-free. Can I send a text?

You cannot use your phone to operate a cell phone or other device beyond a single touch, even if it is mounted. Use voice-activated commands instead.

**Q** Can I use Bluetooth or my vehicle's built-in system?

You can use hands-free technology such as Bluetooth or integrated systems within the vehicle as long as you do not manually use the system. Anything more than a single touch is against the law.

**Q** What if I see a crash or have an emergency?

You can use a cell phone to call or text 911 to report an emergency or seek help.

**Q** When does this law take effect?

Beginning June 30, 2023, police will start issuing citations for violating this law.
